

It was time for the baby to be born. But Mary and Joseph had to travel to the town of Bethlehem, because the Roman Emperor had ordered them to.



A fun and simply retold nativity story. The book is using glow-in-darkness ink to show the way to the Light of the World!


# Baby's Picture Bible



(Acts 1 & Revelation 21)




### Daniel in the Lions Den

They decided to go and find the new king. They took with them gold, frankincense, and myrrh.


